

HOW TO START FROM DEMOCRACY AND END UP IN A CONCENTRATION CAMP SOME UNQUESTIONABLE REALITIES OF HISTORY

Start:

Democratic states respect individual freedoms including freedom to be an extremist
Extremism exists in many forms, including Socialism. Socialism is the most dangerous form of
extremism because it is based on the well-developed theory of Marx and has massive support from
abroad. Under the normal circumstances Socialists do only one thing: indoctrinate youth. Churchill said
“If you are 18 and not a Socialist, you have no heart, but if you are 30 and are a Socialist, you have no
brain”.

Socialists do not waste a good crisis: during a crisis, adults also become susceptible to Socialist ideas.

Step 1.

Socialists offer to the least productive citizens things that they did not work for.
Government does not produce wealth, it can only print money. Therefore Socialists take these things
away from the productive part of the population.

Step 2.

Socialists demonize the productive part of the population using taxation, restrictions, and accusations in
everything wrong that ever happened in the country. Environmental causes are used to demonize industry

Step 3.

Socialists disarm the population. At the same time they apply very liberal laws to criminals. They change
immigration laws and admit criminals from abroad. Criminals dominate the society victimizing mainly
the productive sector of the population.

Productive population cannot operate under these conditions. People are concerned only about safety.

Economics comes to a halt. Crisis deepens (mass unemployment, deficit, hunger, crime)

Step 4.

To restore the order, Socialists establish dictatorship. The system begins working but very inefficiently.
The lion share of the produced wealth is confiscated by the government. A tiny portion of the confiscated
resources is used to provide free health care, schools, housing, etc.

Members of the ruling elite have their own, quite different, but also free health care, housing, etc....

Step 5.

The developed system is incompatible with the human nature. The government attempts to change the
human nature. As the means of artificial selection, it opens concentration camps and fills them with the
best part of the nation (honest, outspoken, brave, entrepreneurial, etc.) The impact of this artificial
selection could be seen for a century.

Examples: Russia, China, Cuba, North Korea, Former Eastern Europe, Nazi Germany

Possible contra argument: Denmark has Socialism but no concentration camps

My response: Ten years from now there will be concentration camps in Denmark. Dogs will be German
Shepherds and guards will be Muslims
